FOR RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITY IN THE 10-COUNTY AREA



January 2021

January started off strong for the housing market, with healthy buyer demand and strong market fundamentals. A robust increase in housing starts in December points to an active year for new construction, but higher material costs, especially lumber, and a limited supply of buildable lots will temper the number of new units.

New Listings in the Central Mississippi area decreased 11.2 percent to 525. Pending Sales were up 20.7 percent to 572. Inventory levels fell 55.7 percent to 969 units.

Prices continued to gain traction. The Median Sales Price increased 22.9 percent to \$215,000. Days on Market was down 29.5 percent to 49 days. Sellers were encouraged as Months Supply of Inventory was down 62.2 percent to 1.6 months.

The Mortgage Bankers Association's January research estimates approximately 2.7 million homeowners with mortgages are currently in forbearance plans. Some of these homes may eventually come to market, but given the strong appreciation in most market segments in recent years, these eventual home sales are likely to be mostly traditional sellers. However, a modest increase in short sales and foreclosures at some point this year would not be surprising.

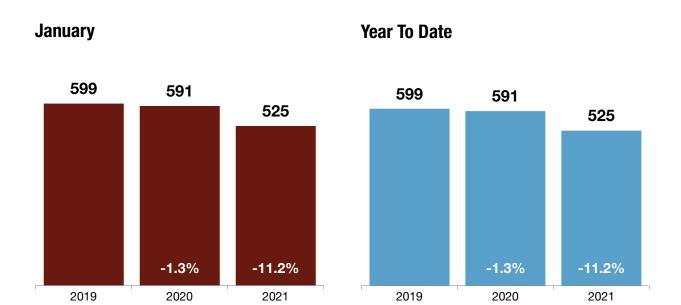

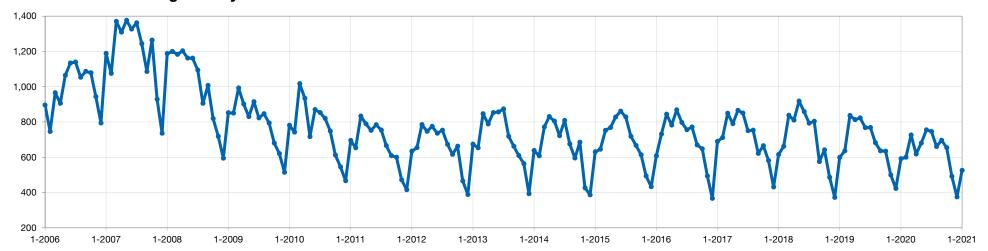

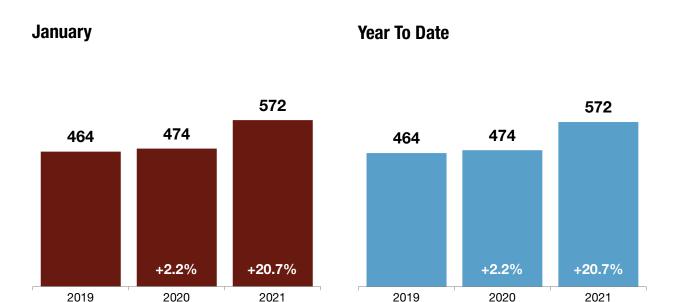

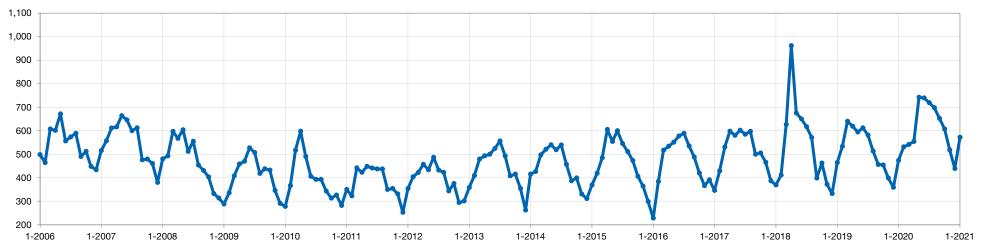

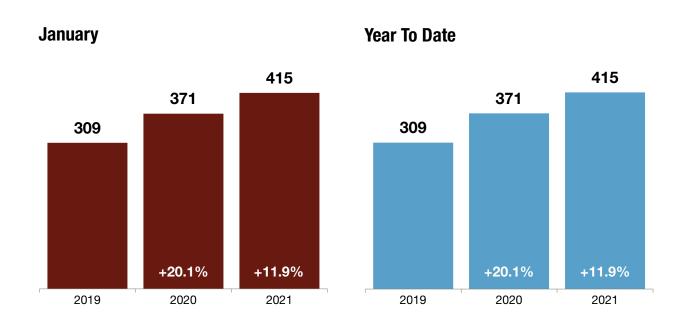

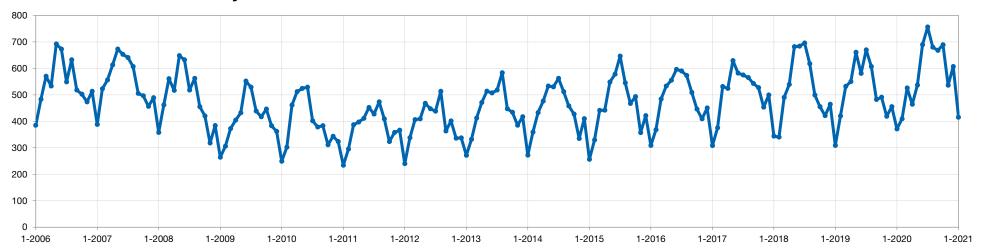

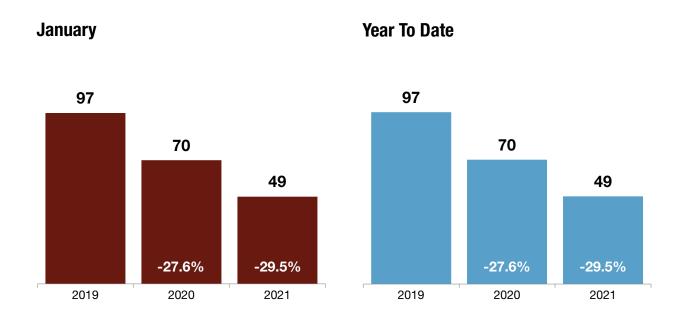

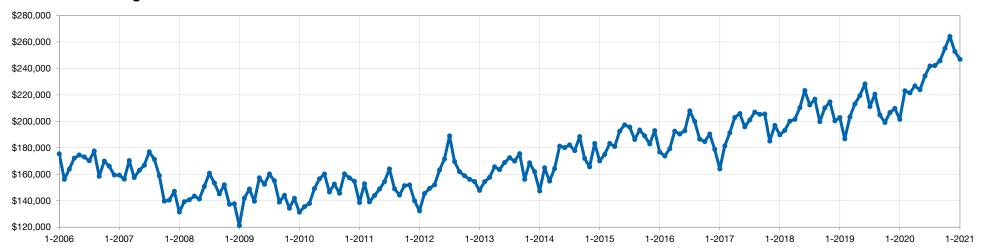

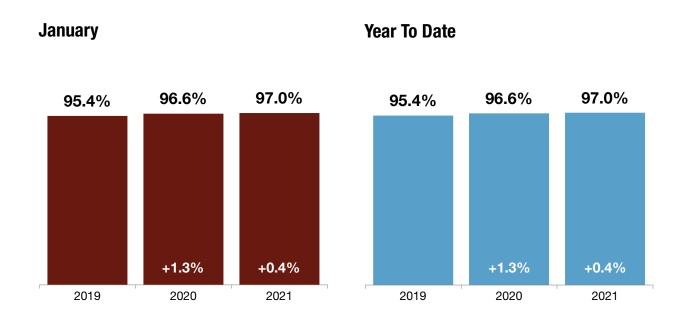

Percent of List Price Received

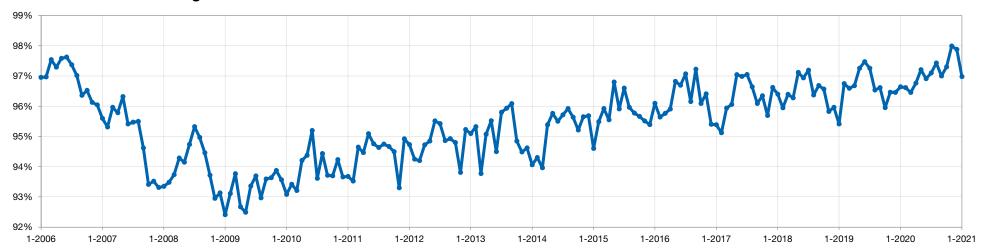

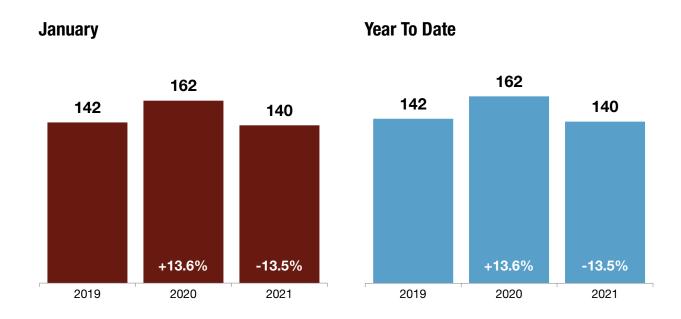
Historical Percent of Original List Price Received



Housing Affordability Index

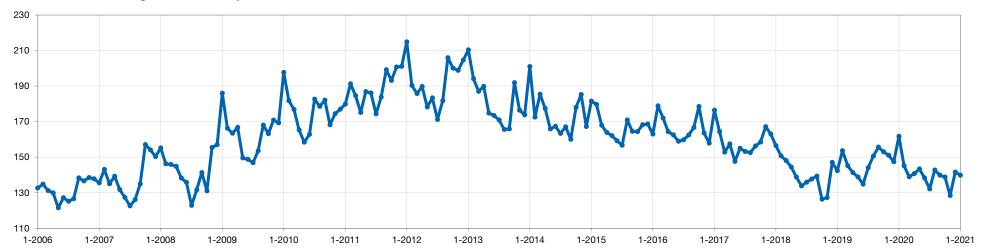

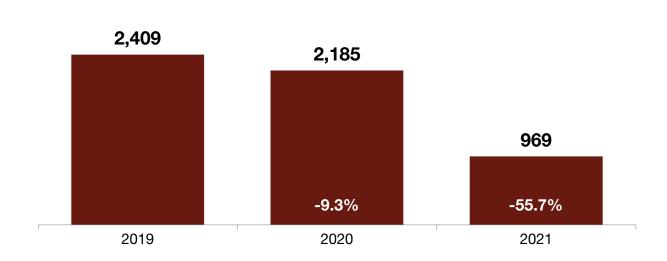

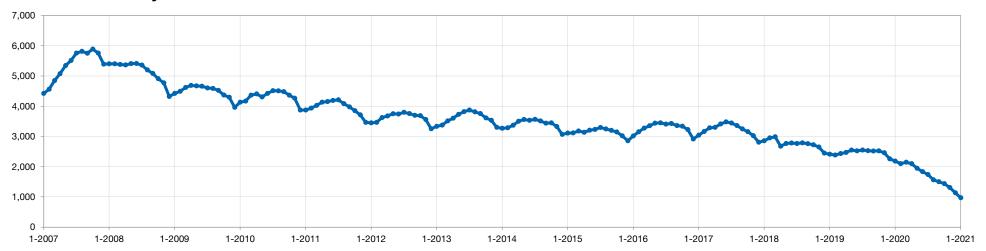

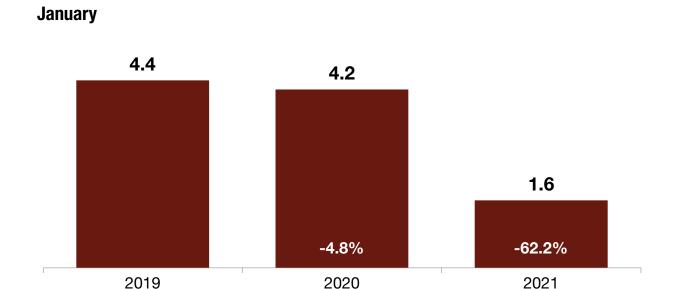
